Yesterday, MRC Action launched a campaign demanding the Smithsonian Institute [remove a highly controversial bust](#) of Planned Parenthood's founder, Margaret Sanger, from the "Struggle for Justice" exhibit at their National Portrait Gallery in Washington, D.C. (The exhibit includes tributes to Jackie Robinson and Martin Luther King, Jr.!)

**Over 700 calls poured into the office of the head of The Smithsonian yesterday, prompting them to call and ask that we stop.**

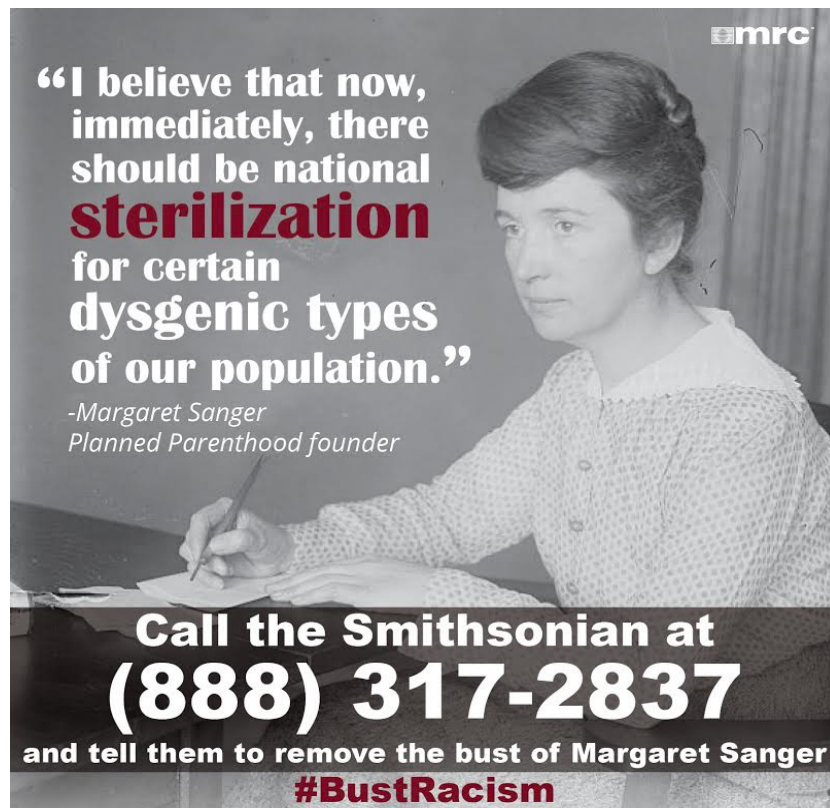
But we're not going to stop. Not as long as they continue to venerate Margaret Sanger at the taxpayer-funded National Portrait Gallery!

This prestigious placement next to so many historical icons makes it appear that Margaret Sanger was a champion herself of the civil rights movement. So what was her big accomplishment? **She led a crusade calling for the elimination of people she deemed “unfit” and inferior, including blacks and disabled people!**



Today, 79% of all Planned Parenthood abortion clinics remain in predominantly black and Hispanic communities, and Margaret Sanger’s influence and legacy lives on in the 700+ Planned Parenthood clinics throughout the country.

The inclusion of Margaret Sanger in this taxpayer-funded gallery is offensive to
