- **Exposing** far-left Big Tech monopolies like Google.

Instead, self-appointed, self-important leftist "elites" who run the establishment news media use their power to spread politically motivated **propaganda** all day, every day.

I'm talking about the leftists who control the Big Three broadcast networks, big city newspapers like the Washington Post and the New York Times, cable networks like CNN and MSNBC, and social networks like Facebook and Twitter.

To these east and west coast "news" media outlets, "**Freedom of the Press**" is freedom only they enjoy — and a punchline to the jokes they tell each other at exclusive highbrow cocktail parties, political dinners, and awards ceremonies.

Remember, these "elites" believe flyover country isn't worthy of admiration, attention, or high esteem.

Far from it.

To them, America's flyover country is filled with "deplorables," uneducated hicks, smelly Walmart shoppers, dumb blue-collar workers, low-IQ farmers, superstitious and bigoted Christians, and dangerous gun owners. In other words:

"We can't trust the unwashed with real journalism. We can't let them decide what is true or false, or what is really newsworthy. They might choose the wrong policies and the wrong candidates — like Trump!"

- **Imagine** what that would look like and how great it would be for our country if the American people could make informed choices based on the TRUTH.
